After a long experience as a researcher in neurobiology, Cécile Lebrand was appointed to supervise the Publications and Research Data Management Unit at the BiUM. She has been developing concrete services and tools to improve the visibility and reproducibility of FBM publications by promoting Open Access models and FAIR/Open data. Her services also aim at helping FBM researchers to better manage their research data by helping them to produce a Data Management Plan when applying for funds (FNS), a Readme file for long term storage and by helping them to share data sets for publication purposes.
