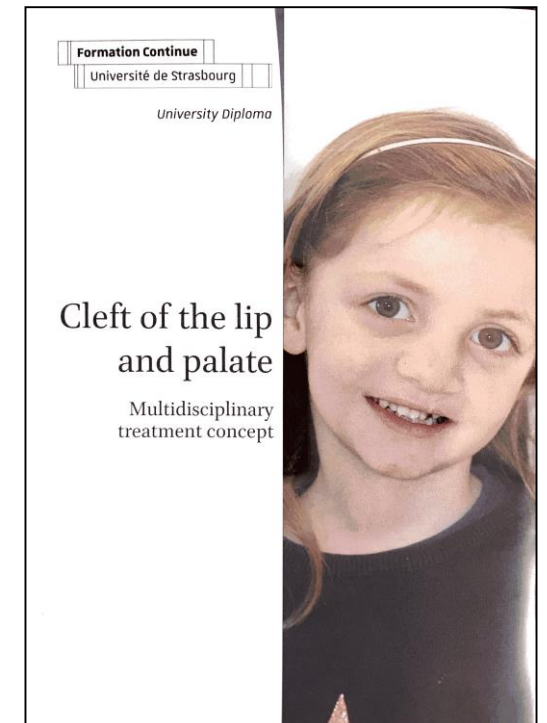
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II. Working together

Dans les jours qui suivent la naissance, presque 90 % des Mamans déclarent donner leur lait, en partie ou totalement et directement au sein ou via un tire-lait et un biberon !

CLP and appearance

- Satisfaction with appearance differs between studies and populations
- A visible cleft seems to lead to lesser satisfaction with appearance than a non-visible cleft (*Berger et al. 2009*)
- However, the severity of disfigurement is not a straight predictor to amount of psychosocial distress! (*Rumsey et al. 2004*)

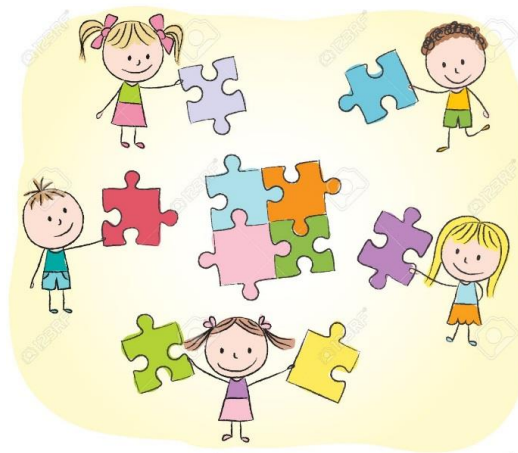


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III. International nurses collaboration
