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Spine Fellowship starting May 1st, 2020

The Lausanne University Hospital is an internationally renowned hospital for clinical practice and research. It is closely associated with the UNIL (University of Lausanne). The spine unit is a completely autonomous, interdisciplinary unit compiled of neurosurgeons and orthopedic surgeons. The fellowship post offers the unique opportunity to enhance knowledge and skills in the entire range of adult spine surgery from trauma, degenerative disease and complex deformity reconstruction to intra- and extra-medullary tumor- and spinal infection surgery. Application of state of the art techniques including intraoperative 3D imaging and surgical navigation, as well as minimal-invasive surgery complete the portfolio.

This fully funded fellowship has a minimum duration of 1 year with the possibility of a 1-year extension (max. 2 years in case of good clinical and academic standing).

Fellowship Requirements:

- Full medical license equivalent to MEBEKO requirements (<u>https://www.bag.admin.ch/bag/en/home/berufe-im-gesundheitswesen/auslaendische-abschluesse-gesundheitsberufe.html</u>
- Absolved training program in Orthopedics or Neurosurgery
- French language proficiency level B2
- Active clinical position in either orthopedic or neurosurgical training program
- Significant activity in clinical and/or basic science research

Applications and Required Documentation:

- Applications are received from *now until June, 30th, 2019* and should include:
 - Curriculum Vitae
 - Letter of Motivation
 - Letter(s) of Recommendation (min.1)
 - o Copies of medical degrees and documentation of absolved orthopedic or neurosurgical training
- Eligible candidates will be notified until July 31st, 2019 and invited for an interview in August 2019
- Definitive confirmation of acceptance will be sent by September 1st, 2019
